

COMMUNITY CARE:

STEPS TO RESPOND TO AN OVERDOSE

1. Check in

Call their name, shake gently, rub knuckles on sternum.

2. Call 911

Say someone isn't breathing.

3. Give naloxone

Spray in nose or inject in thigh/arm.

4. Breathe for them

1 breath every 5 seconds.

5. Don't leave

Give another dose after 2–3 mins if needed. Roll them on their side once breathing.
