COMMUNITY CARE:

STEPS TO RESPOND TO AN OVERDOSE

1. Check in

Call their name, shake gently, rub kn<u>uckles on sternu</u>m.

2. Call 911

Say someone isn't breathing.

3. Give naloxone

Spray in nose or inject in thigh/arm.

4. Breathe for them 1 breath every 5 seconds.

5. Don't leave

Give another dose after 2-3 mins if needed. Roll them on their side once breathing.
